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the summa theologica is the best known work of italian philosopher scholar and dominican friar saint thomas aquinas 1225 1274 widely considered the catholic church s greatest theologian famously consulted immediately after the bible on religious questions at the council of trent aquinas s masterpiece has been considered a summary of official church philosophy ever since aquinas considers approximately 10 000 questions on church doctrine covering the roles and nature of god man and jesus then lays out objections to church teachings and systematically confronts each using biblical verses theologians and philosophers to bolster his arguments in volume ii aquinas addresses happiness good and evil love and hatred hope and despair anger virtue sin and grace and much more this massive work of scholarship spanning five volumes addresses just about every possible query or argument that any believer or atheist could have and remains essential more than seven hundred years after it was written for clergy religious historians and serious students of catholic thought

this is part ii of the treatise treatise on the love of god an authoritative work which reflects perfectly the mind and heart of francis de sales as a great genius and a great saint it contains twelve books the first four give us a history or rather explain the theory of divine love its birth in the soul its growth its perfection and its decay and annihilation the fifth book shows that this love is twofold the love of complacency and the love of benevolence the sixth and seventh treat of affective love which is practiced in prayer the eight and ninth deal with effective love that is conformity to the will of god and submission to his good pleasure the last three resume what has preceded and teach how to apply practically the lessons taught therein

knud ejler løgstrup s the ethical demand is the most original influential danish contribution to moral philosophy in this century this is the first time that the complete text has been available in english translation originally published in 1956 it has again become the subject of widespread interest in europe now read in the context of the whole of løgstrup s work the ethical demand marks a break not only with utilitarianism and with kantianism but also with kierkegaard s christian existentialism and with all forms of subjectivism yet løgstrup s project is not destructive rather it is a presentation of an alternative understanding of interpersonal life the ethical demand presupposes that all interaction between human beings involves a basic trust its content cannot be derived from any rule for løgstrup there is not christian morality and secular morality there is only human morality

engaging with the wide sociological literature on emotions this book explores the social representation of emotions their management and their effects by making reference to creative sources with a specific focus on literary narrative including the works of figures such as dante austen manzoni tolstoy and kundera the author draws out the capacity of literary works to describe and represent both the external aspects of social relations and the inner motivations of the involved actors an interdisciplinary study that combines sociology narratology philosophy historical analysis and literary criticism emotions through literature invites us to re think the role of emotions in sociological analysis employing literary narratives to give plausible intellectual responses to the double nature of emotions their being both individual and social

the works of thomas manton present us with what was most characteristic in the ministry of the english puritans careful solid warm hearted applicatory exposition of the scriptures great pastoral concern and a balanced wisdom
